We are holding our annual Key Stage 4 Careers Convention on Tuesday 19th October between 4:30pm and 6:30pm.

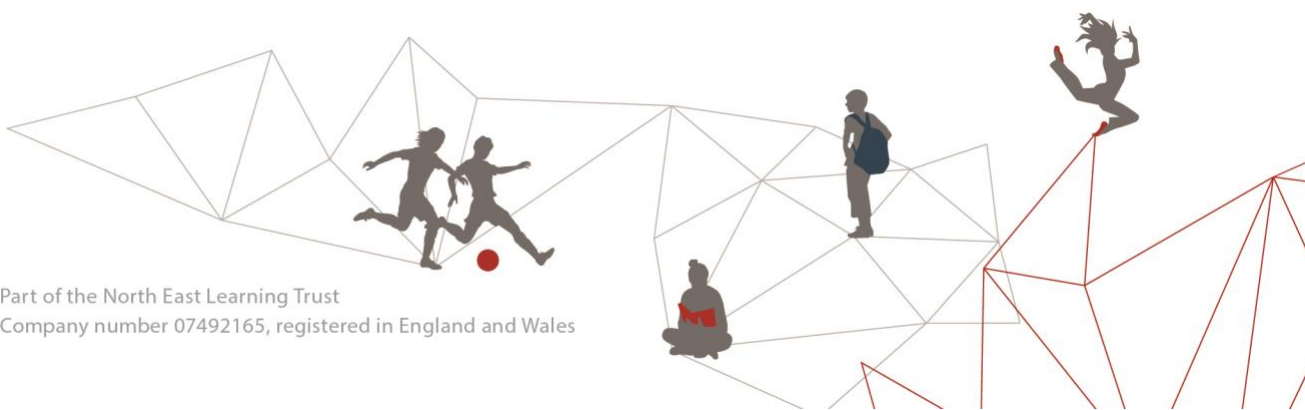
Representatives from a vast number of Post 16 educational establishments, potential apprenticeship and employment providers as well as professional bodies will be attending the evening. You will have the opportunity to discuss the course, pathways and options available at each of the establishments as well as the qualification entry requirements. The representatives will also provide information about the application process.

The aim of the event is to provide you and your child with essential careers information and guidance which will help them to make informed choices regarding the next stage of their education. Staff from the Learning Hub will be available throughout the event should you need further information.

We strongly recommend that you and your child attend this event where you will have the opportunity to discover the wide variety of opportunities that are available for your child Post 16.

Whilst we are delighted to finally be able to welcome visitors into school again, measures have been implemented to ensure everyone's safety:

- In order to limit numbers on site at any one time, there will be 4 different sessions throughout the evening. Please use the links at the bottom of this letter to book your tickets for your preferred timeslot



- Tickets are limited to 1 accompanying adult per student. As this is always an extremely popular event, you are advised to book as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. If you require extra spaces, please contact us and you will be added to a waiting list.
- As you will have the opportunity to speak to representatives from post 16 providers and staff during your visit, we kindly request that all adults complete a lateral flow test before attending this event, wear a face covering whilst indoors, if not exempt, and sanitise their hands on entry to our school. School staff and students will also do this.
- Please do not attend this event if you or a member of your group have any Covid symptoms.
- To ensure adequate distancing and ventilation, the providers will be situated in both the main auditorium and the sports hall of which there will be a one-way system in place. If you can kindly enter via the main entrance, visiting the stalls in the auditorium followed by sports hall and then exiting via the service gates. (staff will be present throughout to guide you through the one way system)
