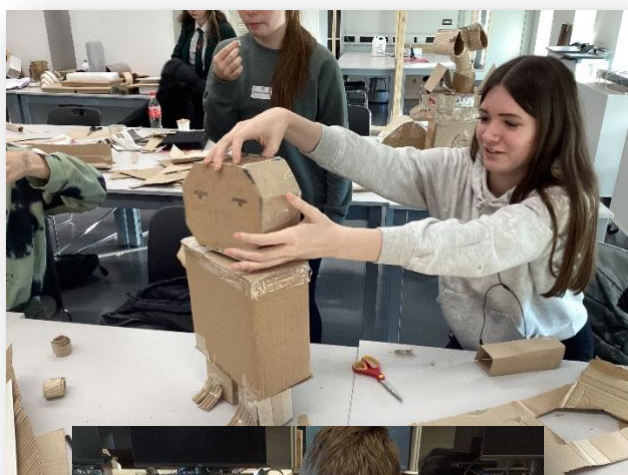
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Northern School of Art Taster Day

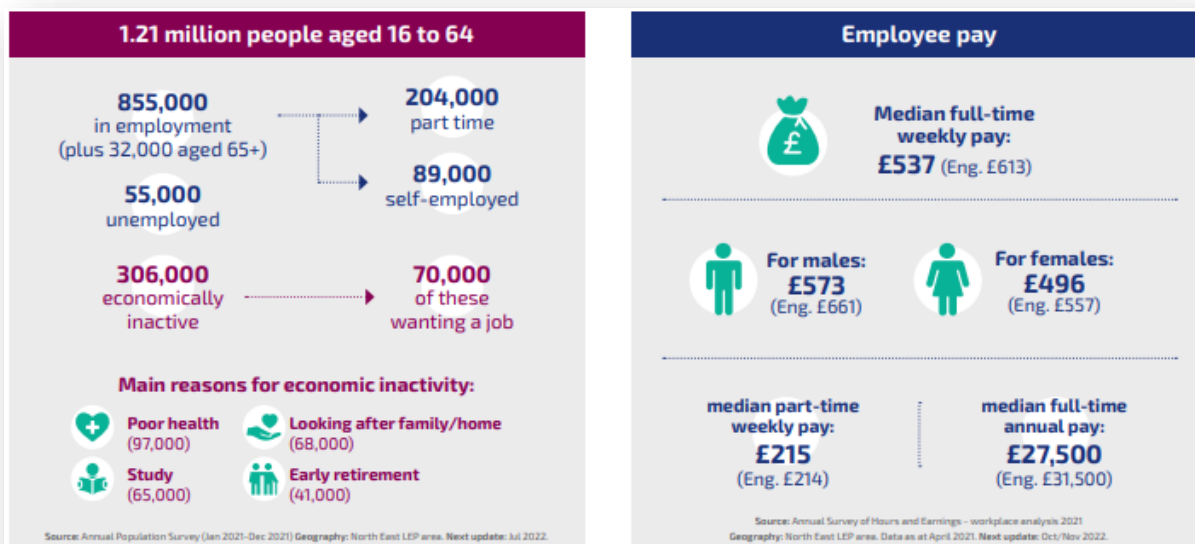
Labour Market Information (LMI) Careerometer
