


Next Tech Girls Online



Important Dates:

- Friday 31st March 2023 All completed placement forms should have been returned to school. If you are waiting to get forms signed, please take the opportunity of the holidays to do so and return them on the first day back.
- If your child is having difficulty sourcing a placement, they are to attend support drop in sessions during Wednesday and Friday breaks. Students without a placement when they return to school on Monday 17th April 23 will be allocated a suitable placement with the support from Futurework.
- April to May Futurework will carry out all necessary Health and Safety checks with the companies to ensure that it is suitable for your child to attend.
- June students will receive relevant details for their placement what to wear, travel and lunch arrangements etc. It is advisable, if students are traveling independently, to complete the journey several times prior to the start date on Monday 10th July 2023


