#### **Veterinary Nurse**

Assisting vets in their work to treat animals, undertake day-to day care of animals recovering from treatment.

### Day to day tasks

- Helping to treat animals
- Care of animals recovering form treatment
- Medical procedures such as wound dressings
- Examine blood/urine samples
- Administer injections
- Prepare and assist in the operating theatre
- Care and preparation of medical utensils
- Initial animal assessments
- Ordering medical supplies
