Year 10 students have been sourcing their forthcoming work experience placements which they will be attending from **Monday 10th July 2023.**

Work experience is a fantastic way of figuring out what you like and dislike about a chosen industry. It can also give students an insight into potential career path. Work Experience can be beneficial in the following ways:

- Gain an insight into an industry that interests you. Work experience allows you to test out different options and get a feel for what you enjoy.
- Establish a professional skill set. Employers can view skills and experience favourably. It can also help you to see what you are good at and what you enjoy.
- Experience what the world of work is like. Getting to see and experience the real working world is valuable for secondary school students.

Students will receive an information pack prior to attending their placement with comprehensive placement details and information. There will be the following forms included that we advise to be completed as evidence of their placement which may be used to support their future careers.

- Personal Work Experience Review
- Self-Skills Assessment
- Employer Assessment/Feedback
