What is it?

Disaster Manager – A Disaster Manager plans for emergency situations such as floods, fires, medical emergencies, nuclear disasters, and other disasters. They play a part in making key decisions when an emergency happens to ensure it is dealt with effectively.

Day to day tasks

- Coordinating with organisations involved in disaster recovery efforts.
- liaise with insurance providers in relation to each situation/case.
- Monitoring the budget for disaster recovery efforts to ensure that costs do not exceed available funds.
- Developing a plan for business continuity and disaster recovery to safeguard against future events.
- Communicating with clients about their needs during times of crisis.
- Developing plans to re-establish operations at a new site if required
- Coordinating with contractors, and other professionals to implement recovery plans.
